The notation '[NP]' in a RRS means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The current FIV Regulations for <u>National Sporting Activities Organized in Italy 2025</u> and the Class Rule Sheet shall apply.
- 1.3 Appendix "P" RRS (Special Procedure for Rule 42) shall apply.
- 1.4 Navigarda ferries have the right of way over any boat racing or not racing. This will not be ground for a request for redress. This changes RRS 60.1(b) and 62.1(a).
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between rules in the NoR, the SIs, or any of the other documents that govern the event under item (g) of the definition Rule, the rule in the SIs or any other document that govern the event will take the precedence. This changes RRS 63.5 (c).
- 1.6 [DP][NP] RRS 40 "Personal Floatation Devices" applies.

- 3.4 **[DP]** From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the Contender Class. Foreign competitors may take part in the event, provided they comply with the requirements of their National Authority and are members of their respective Class Association.
- 4.2 All Italian competitors must comply with the current FIV membership requirements for the current year, including a valid medical certificate and boat liability insurance (with a minimum coverage of €1,500,000.00). All Italian competitors must also be regularly registered with the ICAI Class Association.
- 4.3 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee, to https://fragliavela.sailti.com/it/default/races/race/text/ContenderPre-Worlds2025-it by 18/07/2025 at 23:59.
- 4.4 Entry is completed if all registration requirements are met and if the entry fee has been paid.
- 4.5 The drivers named on the boat entry form shall be the same for all races.
- 4.6 To complete the registration, it is mandatory to send via e-mail at race@fragliavela.org (with subject "CONTENDER DOC #SAILNUM") the following documents by 20/07/2025 at 23.59 the latest:
 - parent/guardian consent form for competitors under 18 years old on 27/07/2025 (downloadable from the ONB); for the duration of the event, each competitor under 18 years old shall be supervised by the responsible adult named on the parent/guardian consent form
 - valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of € 1.500.000,00;
 - for Italian sailors FIV membership with valid medical certificate
- 4.7 All competitors must have signed the registration form in the Race Office before Friday 25/07/2025 at 10:30.







5. FEES

5.1 Entry fees are as follows:

5.2 The entry fee must be paid at the time of registration via PayPal or by bank transfer to the bank details provided in the confirmation email. In both cases, payment fees shall be made by the competitor. No payments will be accepted at the Race Office (neither in cash nor by credit/debit card).

5.3 Cancellation:

- before the 18/06/2025 at 23.59 90% of the entry fee will be refunded;
- in the period between 19/06/2025 at 00:00 and 18/07/2025 at 23:59, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded;
- after 19/07/2025 at 00:00, no entry fee will be refunded.

7. ADVERTISING

- 7.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA within the limits set by WS Advertising Code.
- 7.2 Boats displaying individual advertising must hold a valid FIV (Italian Sailing Federation) license.

9.1 If possible 8 (eight) races will be schedued.







- 9.2 A maximum of 3 (three) races may be sailed on each of the first two days, and 2 (two) races on the last day of the regatta.
- 9.3 One race is required to constitute a series.
- 9.4 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 16:00.

10. [DP] EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 10.1 Prior measurements are not scheduled.
- 10.2 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate. Competitors are encouraged to complete fundamental measurements prior to arrival at the regatta.

11. BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

11.1 All boats shall race with the full sail number stated on the boat's measurement certificate or with the personal number authorized by the Class. Any changes requested in writing may be approved by the RC.

12. VENUE

- 12.1 The races will take place in the waters off Fraglia Vela Malcesine.
- 12.2 NoR Addendum 1 shows the plan of the event venue.
- 12.3 NoR Addendum 2 shows the hospitality information.
- 12.4 NoR Addendum 3 shows the location of the racing area.

13. COURSES

13.1 The course will be described in the SIs.

14. SPARE

15. SCORING

- 15.1 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 15.2 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 15.3 To request the correction of an alleged error in the race result posted on the Official Notice Board, a boat may fill out a scoring inquiry form available at this link: https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/scoring_inquiries/10849/event.

16. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 16.1 Coaches shall register online at:
 - https://fragliavela.sailti.com/it/default/races/race/text/ContenderPre-Worlds2025-it providing the following:
 - a) the characteristics of their support boat;
 - b) the names and sail numbers of the competitors being accompanied;
 - c) to be in possession of a VHF radio.
- 16.2 By signing this registration form, the support person assumes responsibility for launching and supporting the accompanied athletes on the water for the entire duration of the event.







16.3 [DP] Support person vessels shall be marked by a white flag, with a red S and a black number that will be supplied to each coach at registration.

17. BERTHING

17.1 [DP] [NB] Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat park.

18. MEDIA RIGHTS

18.1 [NB] By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the OA and Media Services providers the right in perpetuity, to make, use, and show at their discretion, any photographs, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water, taken during the period of the event, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

19. RISK STATEMENT

- 19.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 19.2 Foreign competitors must comply with any requirements of their respective MNA and hold injury insurance coverage including death and permanent disability, as required by the current FIV Regulations.

20. [DP][NP] ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

20.1 It is recalled the Basic Principle which states: "Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing", it is recommended that carebe taken to protect the environment at all times during and after the event. Especially attention is drawn to RRS 47 -TRASH DISPOSAL- which states: "Competitors and support persons shall not intentionally put trash in the water. This rule applies at all times while afloat. The penalty for a breach of this rule may be less than disqualification.

21. INSURANCE

21.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.500.000,00 per incident or the equivalent.







22. PRIZES

- 22.1 Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - Winner Overall
 - 2° Overall
 - 3° Overall
 - First ranked with age of under 24
 - First ranked with age over 50
 - First ranked with age over 65
 - First ranked of Female competitor

The award ceremony will take place as soon as possible at the end of the event. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

23. [DP][NP] MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 23.1 Competitors automatically grant the OA and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation. This changes Rule 63.4(b).
- 23.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified and supplied by the OA.


